

## **NOTICE OF DECISION**

## TOWNSHIP OF MONTAGUE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING BY-LAW

**TAKE NOTICE** that the Council of the Township of Montague **adopted By-Law 4070-2024 on the 21**st **day of May, 2024**, pursuant to Section 34 of the *Planning Act, RSO 1990*, as amended.

**THE PURPOSE and EFFECT** of the proposed Zoning By-law update is to implement the policies in the recently updated Official Plan, address housekeeping matters, and update the zoning mapping Schedules.

**EFFECT OF WRITTEN AND ORAL SUBMISSIONS:** All written and oral submissions received were presented to Council for consideration, prior to Council making their decision. No objections were received from circulated agencies.

**TAKE NOTICE** that any appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal in respect of the Zoning By-law Amendment must be filed with the Clerk of the Township of Montague not later than the <a href="https://dx.doi.org/10.10/10.10/">11th day</a> of June, 2024. A notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal, and the specific part of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment to which the appeal applies. A notice of appeal must be accompanied by the fee required by the Tribunal.

**TAKE NOTICE** that only individuals, corporations, and public bodies may appeal a by-law to the Ontario Land Tribunal. A notice of appeal may not be filed by an unincorporated association or group. However, a notice of appeal may be filed in the name of an individual who is a member of the association or the group on its behalf.

**TAKE NOTICE** that no person or public body shall be added as a party to the hearing of the appeal unless, before the by-law was passed, the person or public body made oral submissions at a public meeting or written submissions to the council or, in the opinion of the Tribunal, there are reasonable grounds to add the person or public body as a party.

The Decision of the Council of the Township of Montague is final if a notice of appeal is not received before or on the last day for filing a notice of appeal.
